HOW DO WE SELECT AWARD WINNERS & OUTSTANDING ACHIEVERS?

Definition of Award Categories

Award Winner

Every year, the candidate with the highest distinction mark for EACH grade or diploma category will be selected as an Award Winner for their grade / diploma for their respective state or area.

Categories are divided into: (1) Music Theory, (2) Classical Music Practical, (3) Rock & Pop, (4) Speech & Drama. Digital Grade & Diplomas are considered together with Face to Face assessment of the same grade / diploma level.

Duets will be considered together with the solo entries.

Ensembles and choirs will be considered within their own respective categories.

Distinction candidates for ALL instruments and voices within the same grade or diploma level will be considered for the same award.

In the event of a tie of marks, ALL candidates will be given the awards.

Each Award Winner will receive a special certificate as well as a memento in the form of either a medal or plaque.

Outstanding Achiever

The candidate with the SECOND and THIRD highest distinction marks for EACH grade or diploma category will be selected as an Outstanding Achiever.

In the event of a tie of marks, ALL candidates will be given the awards.

Each Outstanding Achiever will receive a special certificate.
